

2. What is the cost of registration to attend the AISA Conference?

2. When does the AISA Conference begin and end each day?

- The first day of the AISA Graduate Pre-Conference begins at 9:00 AM on February 1st., for graduate students
- Days two February 2nd and three February 3rd of the conference begin at 8:00 AM and end at 5:00 PM on both days.
